Glenellen Solar Farm Community Grant Program – 2025

The **Glenellen Solar Farm Community Grant Program** supports local groups with projects and purchases that strengthen participation, facilities and community wellbeing across the Jindera region.

A local Selection Committee of seven community members recently reviewed the applications and approved the following organisations for funding,

Jindera Pioneer Museum	\$22,695	Historic mural to conserve local heritage and improve visitor experience.
Jindera Netball Club	\$18,000	Tables and chairs for the function space, enabling wider community use.
Jindera School of Arts	\$14,728	Air-conditioning install to support year-round hall use.
Jindera Recreation Reserve	\$11,186	Restoration works to stabilise and protect the Jindera War Memorial.
Jindera Theatrical Society	\$9,900	Purchase of wearable microphone headsets for more professional productions.
Jindera Fire Brigade	\$8,000	Safe access pathway on the eastern side of the fire shed.
Jindera Anglers Club	\$6,535	Extension of the clubhouse veranda to increase club and community use
Glenellen Fire Brigade	\$6,370	Security camera system with remote access and backup power.
Jindera Country Golf Club	\$5,500	Repair of flood-damaged putting greens and supply of upgraded putting cups.
Jindera Fire Brigade	\$4,052	Portable battery-powered tools and emergency lighting.
Jindera Tennis Club	\$3,500	Remote lighting controller linked to online booking system.
Jindera Playgroup	\$1,982	Program resources for early learning activities to improve the learning and playing experience.
Jindera Community Garden	\$1,980	Watering system to lessen the workload on volunteers.
